1. What are the criteria for the scholarships?

	*(To apply for Year 8 scholarship, UPSR students must have excellent academic achievement with at least 3A's or above in their UPSR prediction results.)		
Tenure	For 2 years, subject to satisfactory review and renewal.		
Value of scholarship	 100% waiver on Application Fee Registration Fee, Tuition Fee and Security Deposit depends on the percentage of scholarships to be offered. 		

<u>Note:</u> Technology fee, student trip fee, uniform, books and any other miscellaneous that arises are not covered by the scholarships.

2. When should I submit my application form?

All application forms must be submitted to TIS Puchong by 30th September 2019 (Monday)

3. How do I apply and what documents are required?

To apply, students need to complete the application form. The form may be obtained from:

- (i) TIS Puchong campus (hard copy)
- (ii) TIS website: www.tis.edu.my (soft copy)

Applicants are required to submit the following:

- (i) Completed application form
- (ii) School recent reports and certificates (all must be certified copies)
- (iii) A letter of recommendation from Head of School or Teacher

4. How do I know if I am shortlisted for the scholarship assessment exam?

Shortlisted candidates will be notified by phone to come for a written assessment follow by an interview. You do not need to study any particular subject, just to come prepared as you are.

5. Who will be interviewing me?

Members of senior management from Taylor's International School will be interviewing the candidates.

6. What happens if I am sick or absent on the day of the scholarship assessment exam or interview?

You can defer by providing a medical certificate, and contact by phone/email to the scholarship panel, if possible by 2 working days.

7. How can I prepare for the interview?

The interview will be a chance for the Scholarship Panel to meet and know the student better. Applicants should be confident to share and express themselves with the scholarship panel.

8. How soon will I know the outcome of the interview?

Candidates will be notified of the outcome of the interview within 2 weeks by phone from a representative of the Scholarship Panel.

9. If I accept the offer of a scholarship, can I change my mind later?

Yes, you can decline the scholarship (within a week from the receipt of the Offer Letter). However, once declined the scholarship will not be offered again. Once the candidate has decided to accept the offer, he/she must within a week bring the Offer Letter to the Admissions Department to register with the School.

10.. Are there any academic or behavioural expectations attached to the award of a scholarship?

The scholarship may be revoked if there are serious disciplinary offences within the 2 years of the scholarship period. However, this would be after careful consideration and dialogue between the School and the candidate.

It is mandatory for the scholarship holders to pass all the School and public examinations and consistently maintain high academic standards, as well as participate actively in the institution's sports and co-curricular activities (CCAs).

The Scholarship holder is required to diligently attend all classes as required by the School, unless he/she is unable to do so due to illness, in which case a medical certificate must be produced.

The Scholarship holder is required to demonstrate exemplary behaviour and to comply with all the School's rules and regulations at all times. The Scholarship holder is prohibited from engaging in any activity that may adversely affect the School's or TEG's reputation.
