1. What are the criteria for the Secondary Bursary?

Year Group	Year 7, Year 8 and Year 9
Eligibility	Open to Malaysian and expat students. To qualify, applicants must be of the following ages in the year of intake:

Criteria	 Any of the following one criteria: Good academic performance; or Strength or talent such as sport, performing arts, music and others; or Good skills and other attributes
Fees covered by Bursary	 100% waiver on Application and Registration Fees A one-time upfront discount of RM4,000 off Net Tuition Fee
Fees not covered by Bursary	Technology fee, security deposit, student trip fee, uniform, books and any other miscellaneous fees/charges that arises.

2. When should I submit my application form?

Please submit your application form as soon as possible to TIS Puchong Admissions as the Secondary Bursary is limited and subject to availability.

3. How do I apply and what documents are required?

To apply, students need to complete the application form. The form (soft copy) may be obtained from TIS Puchong Admissions Department.

Applicants are required to submit the following:

- (i) Completed application form
- (ii) School recent reports and certificates

4. How do I know if I am shortlisted for the Secondary Bursary interview and assessment?

Shortlisted candidates will be notified on an interview and an assessment by our Admissions Team. During this pandemic period, it'll be done online. Our Admissions Team will be in touch on the arrangement details.

5. Who will be interviewing me?

The Secondary Bursary Panel consisting of the Principal and Head of Secondary shall conduct the interview.

6. What happens if I am sick or absent on the day of the assessment or interview?

You can reschedule the assessment or interview by providing a medical certificate by contacting the Admissions Team.

7. How can I prepare for the interview and assessment?

The interview will be an opportunity for the Secondary Bursary Panel to get to know the student better. Applicants should be confident to share and express themselves with the panel members, and share their achievements.

The student need not study any particular subject, just to come prepared as they are. The Assessment is based on the student's reasoning ability, verbal and non-verbal skills. This helps the school to assess the level of each student's capability.

8. How long will the school take to evaluate the Bursary application?

The evaluation shall take no longer than two weeks.

9. If I accept the offer of the Secondary Bursary, can I change my mind later?

Yes, you can decline the Bursary (within a week from the receipt of the Offer Letter). However, once declined the Bursary will not be offered again. Once the candidate has decided to accept the offer, he/she must within a week notify the Admissions Department to register with the School.

11. Can the Bursary be deferred to another term?

This is not possible. The Bursary is only open for the 2021 intake (Term 3) and 2022 intake (Term 1).
