

IGCSE Scholarships 2022 (External)

1. What are the criteria for Taylor's International School (TIS) IGCSE Scholarships 2022?

Intake	2022 Intake
Eligibility	Open to Malaysian students only. To qualify, applicants must be of the following age in the year of intake: Age Year Group 15 years old Year 10
Criteria	 Excellent academic performance All-rounded with good values and characters Outstanding contributions Able to be an exemplary ambassador of the school
Tenure	2 years
Value of scholarship	 Full/partial scholarship 100% waiver on Application and Registration Fees Security deposit depends on the percentage of scholarship to be offered
Fees not covered	Technology fee, student trip fee, uniform, books and any other miscellaneous fees/charges that arises

2. When should I submit my application form?

All application forms must be submitted to the respective campuses (TIS Kuala Lumpur or TIS Puchong) by **29**th **October 2021 (Friday)**.

3. How do I apply and what documents are required?

To apply, students need to complete the application form. The form (soft copy) may be obtained from TIS website: www.tis.edu.my.

Applicants are required to submit the following:

- (i) Completed application form
- (ii) School recent reports and certificates

4. How do I know if I am shortlisted for the Scholarships assessment and interview?

Shortlisted candidates will be notified by phone to come for an assessment follow by an interview. Our Admissions Team will be in touch on the arrangement details.

5. Who will be interviewing me?

The Scholarship Panel of the respective TIS campuses consisting of the Principal, Head of Secondary and a member of Senior Management shall be conducting the interview.

6. What happens if I am sick or absent on the day of the assessment or interview?

You can reschedule the assessment or interview by providing a medical certificate, by contacting the Admissions Team.

7. How can I prepare for the interview and assessment?

The interview will be an opportunity for the Scholarship Panel to get to know the student better. Applicants should be confident to share and express themselves with the panel members, and share their achievements.

The student need not study any particular subject, just to come prepared as they are. The assessment is based on the student's reasoning ability, verbal and non-verbal skills. This helps the school to assess the level of each student's capability.

8. How long will the school take to evaluate the Scholarship application?

Candidates will be notified of the outcome of the interview within 2 weeks by phone.

9. If I accept the offer of the Scholarship, can I change my mind later?

Yes, you can decline the Scholarship (within a week from the receipt of the Offer Letter). However, once declined the Scholarship will not be offered again. Once the candidate has decided to accept the offer, he/she must within a week notify the Admissions Department to register with the School.

10. Are there any academic or behavioural expectations attached to the Scholarship?

The Scholarship may be revoked if there are serious disciplinary offences within the 2 years of the award period. However, this would be after careful consideration and dialogue between the School and the student.

It is mandatory for the Scholarship holders to consistently maintain good academic standards, as well as participate actively in the school's sports and co-curricular activities.

The Scholarship holder is required to diligently attend all classes as required by the School, unless he/she is unable to do so due to illness, in which case a medical certificate must be produced.

The Scholarship holder is required to demonstrate exemplary behaviour and to comply with all the School's rules and regulations at all times. The Scholarship holder is prohibited from engaging in any activity that may adversely affect the school's reputation.

13. Can the Scholarship be deferred to another academic year?

The Scholarship is only open for the 2022 intake.

14. Can the Scholarship be transferred to another TIS campus?

Yes, subject to availability of place at the other TIS campus. This Scholarship is open to both TIS Kuala Lumpur and TIS Puchong.
